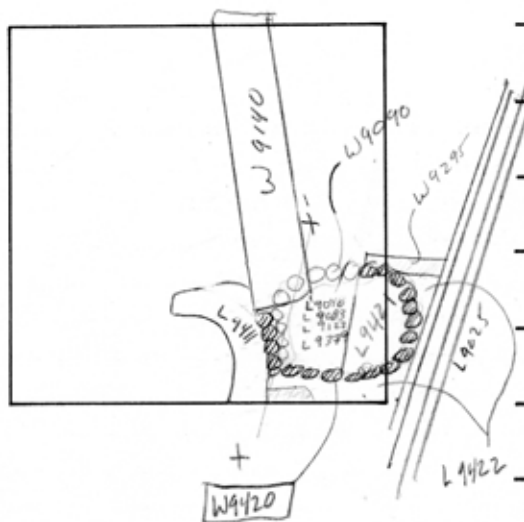

Summary:

Description:

Opened: When [L 9376] came down on stones of [W 9420].

Def/Lim:

North, East and South By Section-Cleaning Locus [L 9422], West By [L 9411] and above, and [W 9140].

Matrix:

Field stones and 2 cut stones ranging from fist size to 50x10x30 cm.

Closed:

When bottom of wall reached and wall was removed.

Relations:

Sump Wall actually consists of [W 9420] [W 9090], part of [W 9140] and possibly rubble of [L 9098]. It is reached by [L 9421], [L 9083], [L 9122] and [L 9379] which make up the fill within the sump. Material surrounding the sump on the north, east and south was excavated as a single locus [L 9422] which is cut by:

The sump wall. Mud brick wall [L 9295] is cut by [W 9420]. It seems probable that [W 9140] is cut by [W 9420], and the cut was then filled by a narrow portion used exclusively as the sump wall.
