DEF./LIMITS: L9444 REACHES THE NORTH, WEST, & EAST BAULKS. TO THE SOUTH WEST IT BORDERS L9390 AND TO THE SOUTH EAST L9435

MATRIX: DARK BLACK/BROWN SOIL WITH SHERDS AND SANDSTONE RUBBLE.

REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON RUBBLE IN NORTHEAST CORNER AND SOIL CHANGED TO A LIGHTER SHADE OF BROWN. END OF SEASON

ONCE CONTAINED THE WALL THAT ENCLOSED THE ROOM THAT THIS FLOOR IS PART OF. L9444 APPEARS TO BE CONTEMPORARY WITH L9435 THE ROBBERTRENCH RUNNING NORTH/SOUTH & BORDERING L9390 TO THE EAST. THE RUBBLE IN THE NORTHEAST PART OF L9444 MAY BE A PILE OF FALLEN STONES OR THEY COULD BE THE TOP OF A WALL THAT EXTENDS BELOW L9444. L9444 MAY ALSO BE ASSOCIATED WITH ROBBERTRENCHES IN SQUARES AC32 & HG33. HOWEVER, SINCE I CANNOT DETERMINE IF ROBBERTRENCH L9444 WAS DUG BEFORE OR AFTER RT L9435,
