

Description: [opened]; When A clear Floor of [L 9380] Was defined [L 9493] Was Assigned To MAKE-UP and material below to new floor.

DEF/lim North By [W 9400] and Pit [9168]. East By [W 9140], South By [L 9494] and [L 9525], West By [L 9501] and [L 9065].

Matrix 1: Ash Plaster Floor (Thru) over Ashy, lt. Brown Soil.

Closed 1: When Floor [9493] Was Revealed.

Relations. 1: [W 9065] Flats above sloping Surfaces,* [L 9493] Apparently continues under [W 9400]. Cut By Pit [9168].

[W 9140] Flats over sloping surfaces. Reaches [L 9501], [L 9525] and [L 9494] (All Part of The Sloping Surfaces).

Floor [9493] is Probably The Same as SURFACE IX OF [L 9525].

* The sloping Surfaces Are a series of about 15 floor Resurfacings. The First 9 Reach The North Face of [W 9412], and continue under [W 9140, 9065/66 and (W 9400)]. They Are The earliest Phase west of [W 9140]. They consist of [L 9380, L 9493, 9494, 9494, 9501, 9502,] and [9525]. [L 9494] SURFACE SLOPES →
