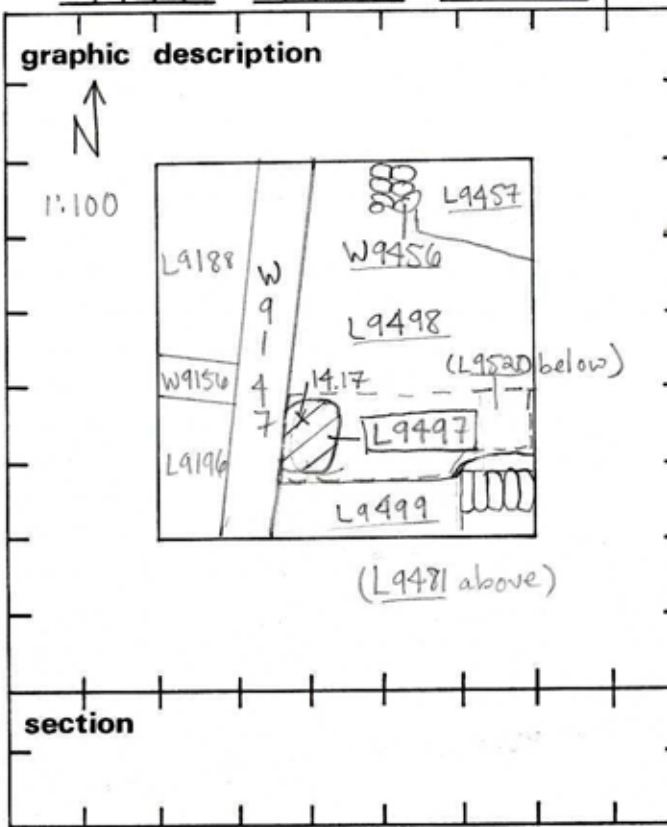

Description: <u>REASON FOR OPENING</u> : CAME DOWN ON GREY CHARCOAL MATERIAL.			
DEF./LIMITS: <u>L9497</u> IS A PIT SURROUNDED BY <u>L9498</u> IN THE NORTH, EAST & SOUTH. IT EXTENDS TO THE WEST INTO THE SOIL UNDER <u>L9454</u> .			
MATRIX: GREASY BLACK/GREY ASH & CHARCOAL WITH VERY LITTLE POTTERY.			
REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON BROWN SOIL WITH BITS OF CHARCOAL, THE SAME SOIL AS IN THE LARGE PERSIAN PIT.			
RELATIONS: <u>L9497</u> IS DIRECTLY BELOW <u>L9481</u> PART OF THE PERSIAN PIT. IT IS DIRECTLY ABOVE <u>L9520</u> WHICH IS ALSO PART OF THE PERSIAN PIT. <u>L9497</u> IS A SMALLER PIT THAT CUTS <u>L9498</u> WHICH IS ALSO PART OF THE PERSIAN PIT. <u>L9497</u> ALSO EXTENDS INTO THE SOIL UNDER <u>L9454</u> BUT ITS EXTENT IN THIS AREA IS UNKNOWN UNTIL <u>W9147</u> IS REMOVED. THOUGH <u>L9497</u> APPEARS TO CUT THE BIG PERSIAN PIT IT MOST LIKELY IS JUST AN ISOLATED DUMPING INTO THE LARGER PERSIAN PIT. <u>L9497</u> IS PROBABLY NOT DISTURBED.
