Summary:

Description:

Reason for Opening: L9191, L9500, and L9276

were recognized as being the same and were collapsed.

Matrix: mudbrick material on grey, faint floors w/ large amounts of sherds and in situ pottery and many bones; also charcoal and burnt seeds.

Definition/Limits: bounded by W9216 and the material beneath W9085 to the North, by W9408 to the West, by L9407 to the South and by pit L9186 to the East.

Reason for Closing: not closed, end of '89 season.

Relationship to Other Elements: L9548 is covered by L9191, L9276, L9500, and by F9276. It is cut by L9186. L9548 reached L9277 and was of the same depositional unit.* L9548 reaches

W9408, and W9216 - both mudbrick walls.

Floor II, in the room defined by W9408 and

W9216 (Floor I is F9276) in L9548, reaches

W9216, but does not reach W9408. Floor III in L9548

which crosses above and below Floor II

* L9548 was 2cm above ^(at end of '89 season) L9407, the continuation

of L9277. Upon reaching L9407 in '91, L9407 and

L9548 should be collapsed.
