Opened: To remove debris from erosion since 1989 season

Limits (N) Bounded by north bank of AI32

(S) Bounded by L9099

(E) Bounded by east bank of AI32

(W) Bounded by L9507

Closed: Began to come down on 1989 loci levels; divided into two new loci: L9612 - mudbrick debris and L9629 - fallen cobble stones and mudbrick

Matrix: Crumbly, grey soil with very few pot sherds

Relations: L9601 was the "Cleaning" locus assigned at the beginning of the 1991 season for the area previously defined as L9375 & L9369, both of which were the floor-make-up of drain L9109; L9601 is non-stratified wash which covers L9369 and L9375 (but does not seal them). To the North, L9601 reaches the material at bank line between AI32 and AI33 but, since AI33 has not yet been excavated here, we cannot yet determine the relation

Additional Observations/Value: L9601 has no meaningful value for stratigraphic analysis

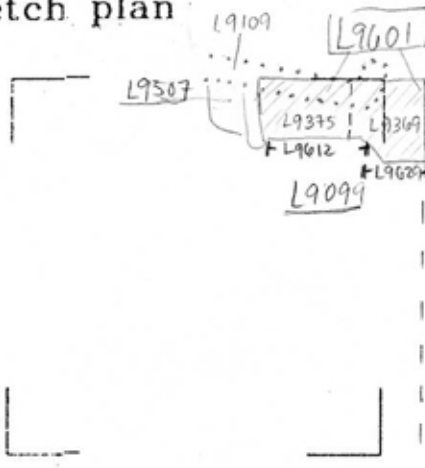
