Summary				

Opened: Opened this cleaning locus to remove 2 years' erosion and wash and to make AJ34 a uniform level

Limits (N) bulk (up)

(S) drain L9103

(E) E. bulk

(W) bulk (descending into AJ34)

Closed: Closed after 10 cms non-stratified wash removed and could define loci using soil changes and cleaned architectural features.

Matrix: The non-stratified wash v. was bleached gray, loose and at uneven, disturbed levels throughout AJ34, comprising L9602

Relations: Once the non-stratified wash in L9602 was removed, the soil below was markedly different in different locus areas with regard to sherd, shell concentration and soil texture and color. L9602 is bound at the south by drain L9103 and at the southeast by drain L9111. L9602 extends to the northern bulk rising out of AJ34 and the eastern bulk sinking into AJ34 (incl. L9085 foundation wall). L9602 covers all subsequent loci below it. L9602 is wash and erosion which flowed into the square over the course of 4 years. As such, its only meaningful relationship is that it covers all loci below it: 9613, 9614, 9615, 9616, 9617 and 9618.


