Summary

Opened: When non stratified wash L9609 was removed to a level slightly below level of 1986 (L9062)

Limits (N) L9053, L9659 and W9058 (W.9058 = L9052, L9053, L9058, L9068)
(S) Balk
(E) Balk
(W) L9641

Closed: When the locus below 9053 (=9659) was taken down level to L9620 and it was seen that they were the same debris; L9620 and L9659 became L9672.

Matrix: The fill is greyish, loose ashy material similar to L9606. It is filled with pottery, amphora handles, storage jar fragments, shells and some terra sigillata. One very large bone was found.

Relations: L9620 is cut by W9058, and W9047 probably cuts L9620. *A 0 may cut a threshold area east of the the preserved portion of W9636 because W9636 ends in an ashlar finished block. If so the pit comes down just in the area of the door. L9620 seems to continue into the east balk below L9068 and into the south balk. L9620 is a continuation of 9659, which is pit material below L9053. Whether the pit material of 9620 continued north beyond 9059 is uncertain because of a lack of descriptive material in the locus card from 1986. The evidence in the south balk suggests that the pit continued south of L9659. How high above the opening of 9620 the pit began can not be exactly determined because of lack of 1986 information. 9620 is covered by but is not sealed by 9609. 9620 covers, but does not seal 9672.
 * The pit of which 9620 is a part (9620+9659+9672). 9672 is covered by 9609.

Additional Observations/Value: Persian, Hellenistic pit material. Its northern extension⁽⁹⁶⁵⁹⁾ is sealed below L9053.

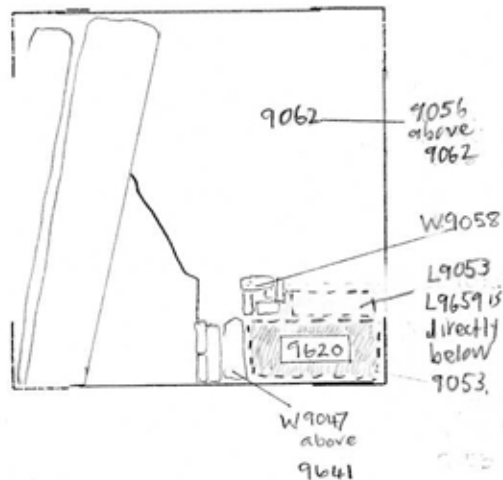
