Summary

Opened: When cleaning L9607 reached the cobble floor of L9044 which was reached in 1986

Limits (N) Bounded by L9056, removed in 1986.  
 (S) Bounded by L9627  
 (E) Bounded by W9047  
 (W) Bounded by material below drain 9025

Closed: When the top north most course of W9636 was reached along the S. edge of L9621

Matrix: The compacted yellow-grey soil is completely different from the mudbrick debris in L9635 which is below. L9621 is the makeup and fill below the floor.

Relations: L9621 is the cobble makeup of the floor of L9044 and the fill below to the level of the top N. course of W9636. The SE area of L9621 seals W9636. L9047 is probably a wall; no cobbles were found below it; it probably cut L9621. In the area of L9627 pier L9052 cut L9621, no cobbles below L9052. A space between L9058 and L9621 is drawn on locus card L9056 04/08/36 for the first time. It is unclear exactly what the relationship was from the drawing or the notes. The fill below the cobbles of L9621, the fill of L9627 and the fill below the cobbles of L9628 are all the same debris and they were only differentiated because L9621 and L9628 were sealed by cobbles and L9627 was not. It was under L9052. The L9621 may continue into balk below L9025, a Roman drain floating above it.

Additional Observations/Value: Important, sealed deposit below a cobble floor.

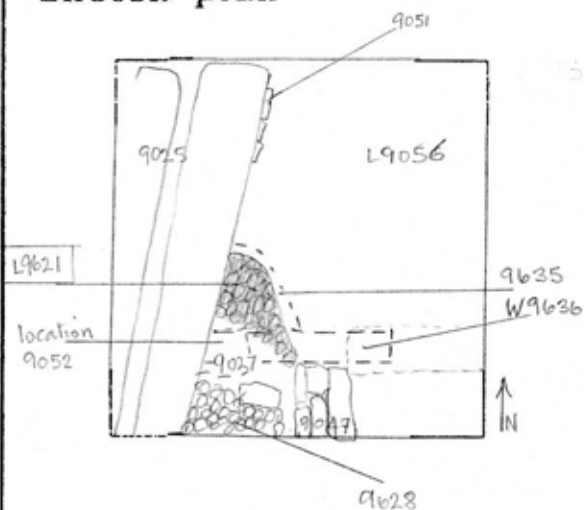
