Summary

Opened: Hardy mud-brick material dredged while excavating L9619

Limits (N) Bounded by L9648

(S) Bounded by fill below L9111/L9025

(E) Bounded by fill below W9051

(W) Bounded by L9107

Closed: when locus reached layer of mudbrick visible in bank on western side of locus.

Matrix: Compact mudbrick debris, hard grey soil darker than L9619 above. No shell (unlike L9619 and L9107). Similar to L9648. High quantity of sherds. There is possibly a layer of tabun material which runs through this locus, and large quantities of ash.

Relations: L9619 cuts or covers L9639 (the pottery from L9619 is predominantly Roman unlike the pure IA in L9639). L9664 cuts L9639. The fill below L9111/L9025; L9664 is a large Persian pit. L9639 is cut by L9107. L9107 is a mixed fill with period assignments from IA to Roman. L9639 reaches fill below W9051. L9639 is probably a continuation of L9648 - both the matrix and pottery appear identical. L9639 is also probably a continuation of the fill below W9051 since both appear to have a similar matrix.

Additional Observations/Value: This is a pure IA deposit stratified below a Roman fill.

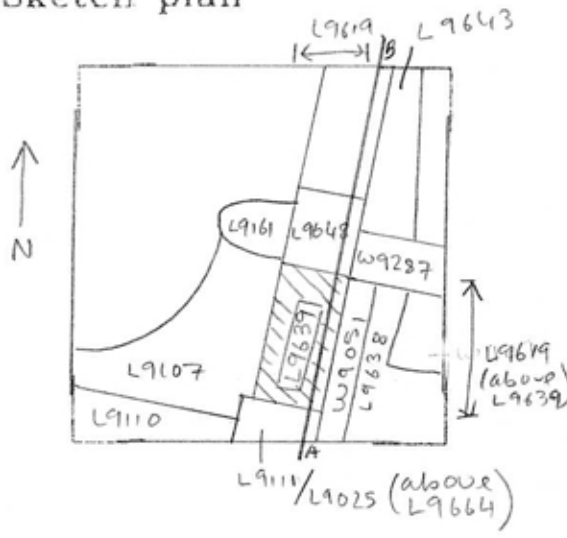
