Summary

Opened: When cleaning locus [L9603] was removed and grey ashy soil of [L9669] was uncovered, along with the fallen mudbrick material of [L9668].

Limits (N) Bounded on the North by [L9663].

(S) Bounded to the South by the southern edge of AK33.

(E) Bounded on the East by [L9668].

(W) Bounded on the West by similar unexcavated material below [W9147].

Closed: When grey ashy material of pit [L9669] was removed to reveal fallen mudbrick material of [L9679] below.

Matrix: Grey ashy material with many pot sherds and bones, patches of soft, semi loose yellow to brown sandy fill, and some charcoal, interspersed with some fallen mudbrick material.

Relations: [L9669] is covered by cleaning locus [L9603], to which it has no stratigraphic relationship. [L9669] cuts [L9668]. [L9669] is probably the continuation of [L9663], which is of a somewhat similar matrix and proper position to be the same pit. [L9669] also cuts the portion of [L9679] which occurs beneath it and extends beneath the baulk below [W9147]. [L9669] and [L9663] can also be said to be continuations of one another because their extensions both continue beneath [W9147] to produce one continuous lens of pit material in the baulk below [W9147], on the East face below [W9147] (continuation of [L9669]) and on the cut North face below [W9147] (continuation of [L9663]). Since the pit material below [W9147] is continuous, the loci which extend from this material, [L9669] and [L9663] are also continuous. [L9669] is also the continuation, separated by cleaning locus [L9603], of [L9516] from the '89 season.

Additional Observations/Value: Persian pit cut by Pis's wall (W9147) which cuts fallen mudbrick material. Unsealed pit; little value.

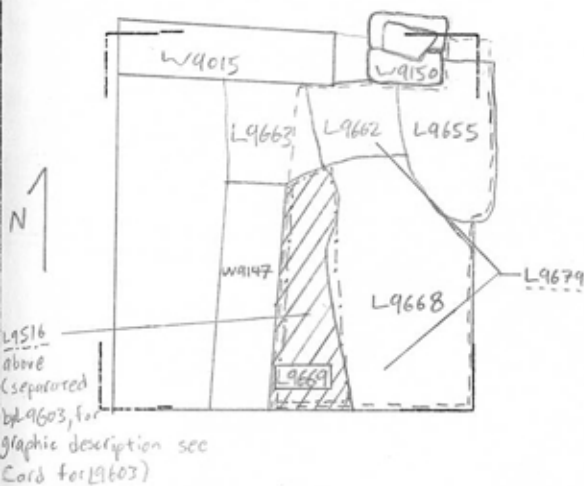
