Opened: W9278's central pier cut into two mud-brick debris loci L9708 and L9709, which began at the base of of the rubble in W9278. See section.

Limits (N) L9674, L9687, L9693 and L9699
 (S) L9666 and L9717
 (E) W9278 and top of FT it's FT.
 (W) W9684

Closed: When L9708 reached base of FT for W9278. Collapsed into L9722

Matrix: Compact mud-brick debris mixed with tertiary and first-sized cobbles. Similar to mud-brick debris loci to east, north, south and west (979674, 9687, 9693, 9699, 9722, 9711, 9666, 9665, 9638, 9692, 9639, 9668 and 9694).

Relations: W9278 covers and seals L9708. W9278 cuts L9708 on the east. L9708 reaches W9684. L9708 is probably a continuation of L9674, L9687, L9693 and L9699 to the north, and also a continuation of L9666 and L9717 to the south. There are all mud-brick debris loci. L9708 continues below in L9722.

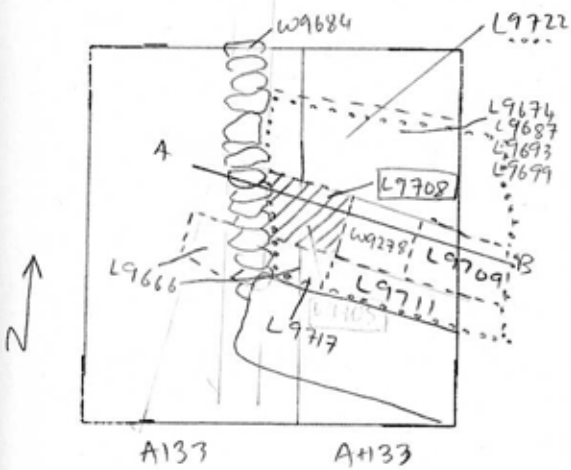

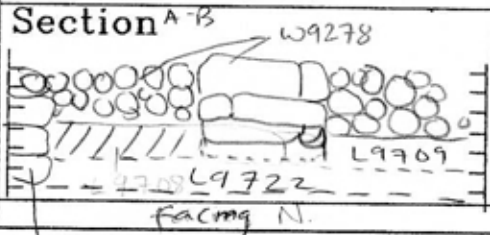
Sketch plan
