Summary

Opened: Came down on [F9763]; closed [L9763] and opened [L9764] as floor makeup and fill down to floor [F9764]

Limits (N) Bounded by [L9095] and material below; and by [L9694] and [L9732]
(S) Bounded by [L9660]
(E) Bounded by material in East bank of AI33 and AI32
(W) Bounded by [L9664]

Closed: Came down on [F9764]; closed [L9764] and opened [L9770] as floor makeup and fill below

Matrix: Very similar to that of [L9763] above; grey, crumbly material, but with increasing amount of mudbrick debris. Small amount of pottery and few bones. Floor very fragmentary, consisting of very thin patches of crushed kurkar, increasingly patchy to West.

Relations: [L9763] and [F9763] cover completely, but do not seal, [L9764]. [L9764] and [F9764] cover completely, but do not seal, [L9770] due to the fragmentary condition of [F9764].

To the North, fill and floor of [L9764] reach the material below [L9095]; the fill of [L9764] continues into [L9694], and may be identical to it. No floor, however, was observed in [L9694]. The fill of [L9764] continues into that of [L9732], and is probably identical to it. No floor, however, was observed in [L9732]. Matrix of [L9732], brown-grey mudbrick debris is similar to that of [L9764], as is that of [L9694], mudbrick debris, as [L9764] goes down.

To the South, the fill and floor of [L9764] continue into, and are probably identical to, the fill and floor of [L9660].

To the East, [L9764] and [F9764] reach the bank of AI32 and AI33.

To the West, [L9764] is probably cut by pit [L9664]. [F9764] is also probably cut by [L9664], but we cannot say for certain due to the fragmentary condition of [F9764].

Additional Observations/Value: Since unsealed, probably, only of medium value.
