Summary

Opened: To excavate continuation of pit [L9736], not completely excavated at end of 1991 season

- Limits (N)** Bounded by [W9704]
- (S)** Bounded by [L9765] and material below, [L9779]
- (E)** Bounded by [L9737] and material below, [L9779]
- (W)** Bounded by [L9765] and material below, [L9779]

Closed: Reached bottom of pit, destruction material surrounding it; collapsed [L9766] with [L9765] to the South, which contained identical destruction material and at same level; opened [L9779]

Matrix: Soft, grey-brown soil, with small bits of charcoal, tip lines of whitish ash material; numerous sherds, many of them diagnostics (lamp fragments; painted decoration), many bones and shells; matrix clearly distinct from bright oranges and reds of destruction debris surrounding it

Relations: [L9736] covers but does not seal, [L9766]. [L9766] covers a small section of [L9795] to its North, but does not seal it. [L9736] appears to have been cut from [L9727] (1991 season) and [L9727] laid after [L9736] was cut

To the North, [L9766] appears to reach [W9704], but until [W9704] is excavated their relation cannot be determined with certainty. [L9766] cuts the destruction material that surrounds it and this destruction material appears to continue into [W9704]

To the South, [L9766] cuts [L9765] and [L9779] below [L9765].

To the East, [L9766] cuts [L9737] and [L9779] below [L9737].

To the West, [L9766] cuts [L9765] and [L9779] below [L9765].
