Opened: In excavating [L9770], came down upon mudbrick debris to west, mudbrick wall [W9728] in center, and [F9770] (fragmentary) to East; opened [L9776] to West and [L9775] to East of [W9728]

Limits (N) Bounded by [L9694]
(S) Bounded by [L9733]
(E) Bounded by [W9728]
(W) Bounded by [L9664]

Closed: Brought [L9776] down to 1991 locus [L9694] to North; since material identical, collapsed [L9776] with southern end of [L9694], opened [L9807] to excavate material below, to [W9262] to North

Matrix: Grey-brown to chocolate-brown mudbrick debris, hard and crumbly; several stones tumbled from some nearby wall (presumably), fist to double-head sized, with no architectural context; small amount pottery

Relations: [L9770] covers, but does not seal, [L9776]. [L9776] covers the southern half of [L9807], but does not seal it.


To the North, [L9776] continues into mudbrick debris [L9694], and is probably identical to it.

To the South [L9776] continues into mudbrick debris [L9733], and is probably identical to it.

To the East, [L9776] reaches [W9728], and is probably debris (at least in part) from [W9728].

To the West, [L9776] is cut by pit [L9664]

Additional Observations/Value: Since unsealed, and subjected to erosion at the West, of little to medium value.
