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Summary

Opened: When L9827 was removed it became apparent that the rubble at its E. border was a small wall.

Limits (N) L9817

(S) Small area of unnumbered fill between W9845 and W9729

(E) W9266

(W) L9827

Closed: Not closed - End of season.

Matrix: Two courses of small, fist-sized cobbles.

Relations: L9759 covers but does not seal W9845. To the N., L9817 reaches the N. end of W9845. W9845 may continue to the N. below L9817, though this remains uncertain. W9845 appears to abut against the W. face of W9266. To the S., the relationship with W9729 is uncertain. There is a small area of light grey fill (approx. 15cm by 15cm) between the two walls. It appears that W9845 does not relate directly to W9729. The top of W9845 is at the same level as the top of L9827. The top of W9845 may be related to the surface of this possible mudbrick installation. There is a thin line of loose grey soil between the wall and L9827. Otherwise, it is uncertain whether W9845 cuts L9827 or is reached by the locus.

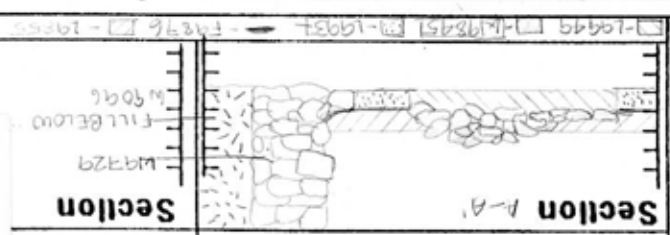
Closed: WHEN THE STRUCTURE APPEARED TO FLOAT, IT WAS REMOVED.

Matrix: PRIMARYLY FIST TO DOUBLE FIST-SIZED COBBLES, WITH A FEW THAT ARE HEAD SIZE, ONE TO THREE COURSES HIGH AT REMOVAL. IT APPEARS THAT AT LEAST ONE ADDITIONAL COURSE WAS REMOVED IN 1992 BEFORE THE WALL WAS IDENTIFIED AND BY WINTER EROSION.

Relations: [L9855] REACHES [W9845] ON THREE SIDES. [W9845] ABUTS AGAINST THE WEST FACE OF [W9266]. [F9876] REACHES [W9845] ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH AS WELL AS A FRACTION ON THE WEST BY THE SOUTH CORNER. AT ITS REMOVAL, NO FLOOR WAS DISCOVERED BELOW THE LAST COURSES. [F9876] REACHES THE SECOND PHASE OF [W9684] AND [W9266] AS WELL AS THE FIRST PHASE OF [W9729] AND [W9211] AT THE SAME LEVEL THAT IT REACHES [W9845]. [W9845] BOTH COVERS AND SEALS [L9949] FOR ADDITIONAL RELATIONS, PLEASE SEE PREVIOUS SEASON'S CARD.

[W9845] APPEARS TO BE NOT A WALL BUT A BENCH OR BENCH-LIKE STRUCTURE. IT IS UNLIKELY THAT A SMALL WALL WOULD ABUT [W9266] AND RUN THE SAME DIRECTION FOR 1 METER, STOPPING JUST SHORT OF [W9729]. THERE IS NO EVIDENCE OF A PART OF THE STRUCTURE HAVING BEEN ROBBED OUT, OR THAT A SECTION WAS ACCIDENTLY REMOVED. IT IS, HOWEVER, JUST ABOUT THE RIGHT SHAPE AND HEIGHT FOR A BENCH.

Additional Observations/Value: HIGH VALUE IT SEALS A LOCUS AND A FLOOR REACHES IT WHICH ALSO CONNECTS IT TO 4 OTHER WALLS IN THE ROOM. THE BENCH IS IRON AGE
