Opened: FOR CLEANING OF WINTER WASH.

Limits (N) BOUNDED BY W9560 IN AG34, IF 9853 REACHES UNNUMBERED PEDESTAL OF W9560.

(S) BOUNDED BY L9854.

(E) BOUNDED BY EAST BAULK.

(W) BOUNDED BY L9813, L9868 AND L9854

Closed: CAME DOWN ON FLOOR 19853 IN THE EASTERN HALF OF L9863, AND SPLIT INTO 2 NEW LOCI (L9871 AND L9870).

Matrix: THE WESTERN HALF OF 19853 CONSISTS OF A SANDY, ASHY PIT WITH SHELLS, SIMILAR TO DEPOSIT UNDER L9868. THE EASTERN HALF AT FIRST CONSISTED OF MODERATELY COMPACT BROWN SOIL WHICH, AFTER 30CM, CAME DOWN ON FLOOR 19853. FLOOR 19853 IS INTERRUPTED BY A CIRCULAR OUTLINE OF BROWN MATRIX, AND IS PRIMARILY COMPOSED OF CRUSHED <sup>MURKIN</sup>. IT IS A RELATIVELY FLAT AND LEVEL FLOOR.

Relations: 19853 REACHES W9560, THE EAST BAULK, L9854 TO THE SOUTH, AND L9813 TO THE WEST. THE SANDY WESTERN HALF REACHED L9858 TO THE SOUTH. 19853 COVERS, BUT DOES NOT SEAL, L9870 (FLOOR MAKE UP AND FILL BELOW) AND THE EASTERN HALF OF L9871.

19853 APPROACHES THE UNNUMBERED PEDESTAL OF W9560, NOT REACHING IT, SO THAT IT LIES APPROX. 5CM TO THE SOUTH OF IT. TO THE SOUTH, THE FLOOR SLOPES UPWARD, INTO WHAT HAD BEEN L9858 (THE PEDESTAL OF W9732). THE LOCUS OF 19868 WAS DETERMINED TO COME DOWN ON 19853. 19853 REACHES THE EAST BAULK.

LINES OF THE FLOOR ARE VISIBLE IN THE E BAULK, SO THAT IT APPEARS THAT A PATCH OF FLOOR MAY CONTINUE INTO THE E BAULK. THE WESTERLY EDGE OF THE FLOOR IS NOT A CLEARLY DEFINED EDGE, AND PATCHES OF FLOOR INTERDIGITATE WITH THE SANDY MATRIX TO THE WEST, WHICH BECOMES L9871.

- NO MENTION OF A FLOOR AT THIS LEVEL WAS MADE IN THE LOCUS CARDS OF AG34.

Additional Observations/Value: NO STRATIGRAPHIC VALUE. THE FLOOR IS PATCHY AND THEREFORE DOES NOT SEAL THE LOCUS BELOW IT.
