Matrix: THE WESTERN HALF OF L9853 CONSISTS OF A SANDY, ASHY PIT WITH SHELLS, SIMILAR TO DEPOSIT UNDER L9868. THE EASTERN HALF AT FIRST CONSISTED OF MODERATELY COMPACT BROWN SOIL WHICH, AFTER 30CM, CAME DOWN ON FLOOR 3853. FLOOR 3853 IS INTERRUPTED BY A CIRCULAR OUTLINE OF BROWN MATRIX, AND IS PRIMARILY COMPOSED OF CRUMBED ^{MURKIN} IT IS A RELATIVELY FLAT AND LEVEL FLOOR.

Relations: L9853 REACHES W9560, THE EAST BAULK, L9854 TO THE SOUTH, AND L9813 TO THE WEST. THE SANDY WESTERN HALF REACHED L9858 TO THE SOUTH. L9853 COVERS, BUT DOES NOT SEAL, L9870 (FLOOR MAKE UP AND FILL BELOW) AND THE EASTERN HALF OF L9871. F9853 APPROACHES THE UNNUMBERED PEDESTAL OF W9560, NOT REACHING IT, SO THAT IT LIES APPROX. 5CM TO THE SOUTH OF IT. TO THE SOUTH, THE FLOOR SLOPES UPWARD, INTO WHAT HAD BEEN L9858 (THE PEDESTAL OF W9732). THE LOCUS OF 3853 WAS DETERMINED TO COME DOWN ON F9853. F9853 REACHES THE EAST BAULK. LINES OF THE FLOOR ARE VISIBLE IN THE E BAULK, SO THAT IT APPEARS THAT A PATCH OF FLOOR MAY CONTINUE INTO THE E BAULK.
