Closed: A TECHNICAL CLOSURE: W9885 EMERGED WITHIN LOCUS UPON ITS EXCAVATION. [L9864] WAS SUBSEQUENTLY CLOSED AND SPLIT INTO L9889 AND W9885.

Matrix: MODERATELY COMPACT, REDDISH BROWN SOIL. FEW COBBLES, SEEDS, OR ANY MATERIAL OTHER THAN SOIL EMERGED FROM THIS LOCUS. [L9864] YIELD A MODERATE AMOUNT OF IRON SLAG AND SOME STONE TOOLS. MATRIX IS A CONTINUATION OF L9862, AND MATRIX CONTINUES INTO L9889 BELOW. DIFFERS FROM THE GRAY-WHITE ASH SAND PIT L9875, AND THE SANDY WHITE PERWAN'DIT (L9890) TO THE EAST.

Relations: TO THE NORTH, PIT L9875 CUTS [L9864]. TO THE EAST, [L9864] CAME DOWN UPON W9885 AND WAS FURTHER EXCAVATED TO ABOUT 5CM BELOW THE TOP OF W9885. [L9864] COVERS AND REACHES W9885; W9885 DID NOT HAVE A VISIBLE FOUNDATION TRENCH. IN ADDITION, [L9864] IS CUT BY PITS L9863 AND L9890, BELOW. TO THE SOUTH, W9278 IS FLOATING AND WE SHOULD ASSUME ITS PEDESTAL IS A PROBABLE FOUNDATION TRENCH. THE UPPER EASTERN MOST [L9864] IS CUT BY THE UNNUMBERED PEDESTAL BELOW W9278.

[L9864] COVERS, BUT DOES NOT SEAL, L9889. [L9889] IS OF THE SAME MATRIX AS [L9864] AND IS SIMPLY A LOWER CONTINUATION OF [L9864].

[L9864] IS A HORIZONTAL CONTINUATION OF L9862, AS THEIR MATRICES ARE THE SAME, EXCEPT THAT L9862 HAS A HIGHER CONCENTRATION OF CHERDS, BONE, AND IRON SLAG.


Additional Observations/Value: MEDIUM VALUE - APPEARS TO BE A CLEAN, GENERAL IRON AGE DEPOSIT.
