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Opened: Pit could be defined at level to which built between AJ32 and AJ32 had been removed

Matrix: Brown sandy material with a lot of pottery and bone. [L 9892] mudbrick material. Loc [L 9893] and [L 9884] lots of mudbrick material and pottery. [L 9906] brown sandy material on top of [L 9942] big flat rocks (pavement?). [L 9958] brown sandy material with small stones. [L 9977] brown sandy material on top of [L 9993]

Relations: [L 9891] covered but not sealed by E half of AJ32.  
 To the N pit [L 9891] probably cuts [L 9892], cuts [L 9893] [L 9906] [L 9942] and [L 9958]  
 To the S pit [L 9891] cuts [L 9977] and [L 9993]  
 To the E pit [L 9891] continues into square AJ 32: pit [L 9139] + 19475 + L9900.  
 To the W pit [L 9891] cuts loci [L 9884] [L 9942] and [L 9958]  
 It is uncertain if the bottom of pit [L 9891] has been reached. It was excavated to the level of F9947 upon which L9900 (the continuation of [L 9891] in AJ32) seems to end. However, no trace of F9947 was found at that level in [L 9891] [L 9891] thus may continue down.

Additional Observations/Value: Persian pit cutting through the iron age levels
