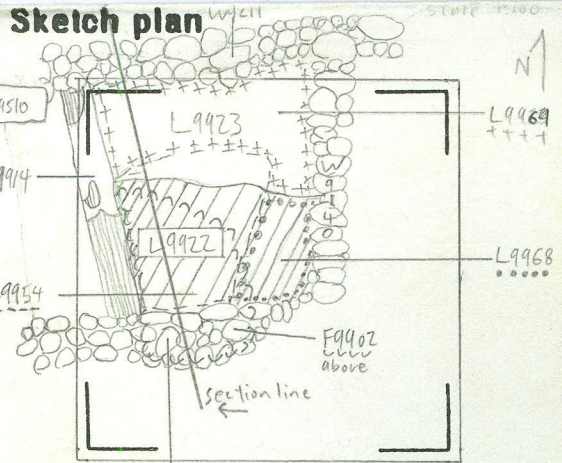


**Sketch plan**

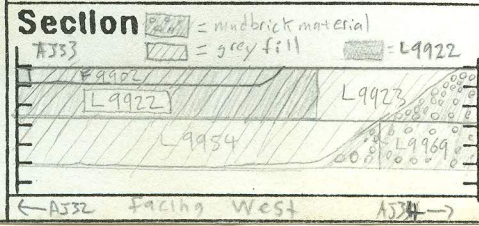


w9066

 W of w9914.

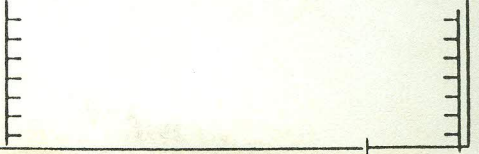

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**Summary**

**Opened:** Came down on W9914 and F9902 in L9902. [L9922] defined as matrix of F9902 and material below, including material of similar matrix to the East not sealed by F9902.

**Limits (N)** Bounded by L9923 to the North.

(S) Bounded by unexcavated material below W9066 to the South.

(E) Bounded by W9140 to the East.

(W) Bounded by unexcavated material below W9914 to the West.

**Closed:** Came down on greyish fill with many sherds in W. two-thirds of locus and brown mudbrick material in E third of locus.

**Matrix:** F9902 was of thin grey ashy material and badly preserved with little sealing value. Locus defined as reddish mudbrick material which extended from below F9902 to the North and East. After excavating through F9902 matrix of grey fill w/ many bones and sherds observed later designated L9954 below.

**Relations:** L9902 covers but does not seal [L9922]. F9902 covers and seals the western two-thirds of [L9922]. Because F9902 was badly damaged it was decided that F9902 was not sufficient for determining the area of the locus below, thus [L9922] extends to the North and East. [L9922] covers the southern portion of L9954 and all of L9968. [L9922] reaches the grey fill of L9923 to the North, W9140 to the East, and the material below W9066. Since W9066 is laid directly on F9902, [L9922] is not cut by W9066, but rather is a continuation of the matrix below W9066. [L9922] is cut by [W9914] to the West\*. After some excavation it was noticed that the reddish mudbrick material defined as the matrix of the locus did not extend below F9902, and this material was actually greyish fill w/ many sherds. Baskets had been separated before this difference created a change in loci, in anticipation of this change. Baskets from the western two-thirds of the locus are the continuation of L9954 below, w/ baskets from the eastern third of the locus belonging to the similar matrix of [L9968] below.

\* The lower portion of [L9922] also continues into the unexcavated fill below W9914.

# F9860 covered and sealed the areas of [L9922] and L9923. Since F9860 may only be a later resurfacing of L9902 (almost immediately below), F9860 may also seal [L9922].

**Additional Observations/Value:** Sealed Iron I fill below partial floor with many sherds. High Value
