Summary

Opened: When horizontal twilight zone L9859 split after coming downen F9859 to the south; the fieldstones of possible sump L9938, and mudbrick material of L9940 in the NE.

Limits (N) Bounded by unexcavated material below W9510 to the North.

(S) Bounded by L9939 to the South.

(E) Bounded by W9914 to the East.

(W) Bounded by L9938 to the West.

Closed: Not closed, end of season.

Matrix: Appears to be mudbrick material. Further matrix description not possible since locus was not excavated this season.

Relations: L9940 is covered by L9859 to the West and may be of the same matrix. Further excavation required to determine this relationship. L9940 probably reaches L9938. The northeasternmost corner of L9938 may actually be the continuation of W9211 below W9510 which may be reached by L9940. L9940 is probably cut by W9914. L9940 reaches and is the continuation of the unexcavated material below W9510. The relationship of L9940 to L9939 is unclear at this time. L9940 is covered by L9902 to the East.
