Summary

Opened: Grey fill observed in western two-thirds of L9922 above, extending partially into L9923.

Limits (N) Bounded by L9969 to the North.

(S) Bounded by the unexcavated material below W9066 to the South.

(E) Bounded by L9969 and L9968 to the East.

(W) Bounded by the unexcavated material below W9914 to the West.



Closed: Not closed end of season. A surface was reached at the lowest level of L9954, however this surface is probably a tip line surface and not a floor. A new locus should be given 94.

Matrix: Semi-loose light grey fill with some sherd, bone, and worked flint. This differs from the fallen mudbrick material of L9968 and L9969.

Relations: L9954 is covered by L9922 and L9923. L9954 is the continuation of the matrix of L9923, which was the upper level of the fill of L9954 as it sloped to the South. The matrix of L9954 is the continuation of the matrix of the western two-thirds of L9922, which was not recognized as such until F9902 had been removed in this area. The fill of L9954 reaches the fallen mudbrick material of L9968 and L9969. The matrix of L9954 continues in the unexcavated material below W9914 and W9066.

IS DP: in 2003 + 2004 it was determined that at the end of the phase 9 destruction there were collapsed masonry piles along the walls, making a "L" shaped configuration. (L9969 + 9968). The hollow between them was gradually filled w. layers of ash & phyto-liths - this is thus per definition, phase 8.

Additional Observations/Value: Iron I leveling fill.
