Summary _____

Opened: L9955 came down on W9960, W9961 and F9955.

Limits (N) W9961
 (S) L9955 and L9971
 (E) L9955 and L9971
 (W) W9975

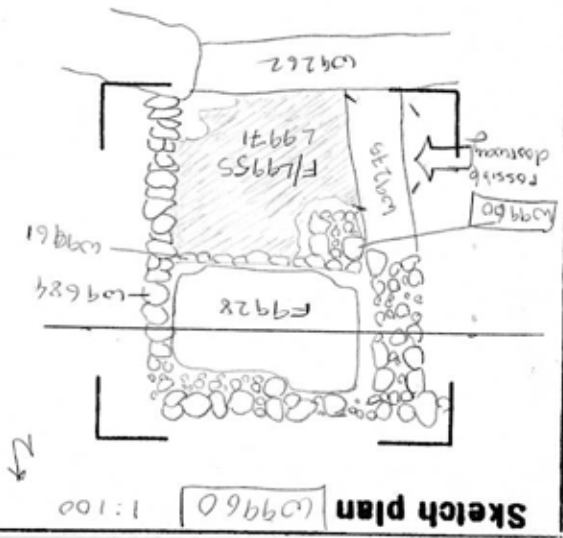
Closed: End of Season - Not closed - wall not removed.

Matrix: A rectangle of stones, some fist-sized, double fist-sized and head-sized. The stones on average are slightly larger than those of W9961 to the N. There are possibly two courses of wallbricks seen in section. It is uncertain to what extent the wallbricks continue S. or whether they are part of W9960.

Relations: L9955 covers but does not seal W9960.
L9955 also reaches the S. and E. face of W9960 because the wall was not recognized until we had excavated down into L9955.
F9955 does not reach W9960.
L9971 probably blocks the stone and wallbrick pedestal ^{L9960 at} S and E faces.
To the N. W9960 dovetails or possibly abuts W9961.
To the W. W9960 abuts a massive stone set below the main line for the base of the socle for W9975. This stone may be an earlier phase to W9975 or very possibly an upper extension of W9960.

W9960 appears to form the N. wall of a passageway or doorway leading under the fill below the socle of W9975. The S. face of the doorway could be W9962 (phase D), and the floor associated with the doorway could be F9955.
W9960 may also be an installation associated with the basin F9928.
F9927 does not cover any of W9960 and thus the wall may have been used in association with both F9955 and F9927.

Additional Observations/Value: Pedestal/wall used as possible doorway/passageway or feature associated with F9928; high value.
