Summary

Opened: Came down on orange mudbrick material in L9923, the upper extension of the sloping grey leveling fill also found in L9954.

Limits (N) Bounded by W9211 to the North.

(S) Bounded by L9954 and L9968 to the South.

(E) Bounded by W9140 to the East.

(W) Bounded by the unexcavated material below W9914 to the West.

Closed: Not closed, end of season.

Matrix: Orange mudbrick material with Kurkar pebbles, few fragmentary bricks, few sherds and bone, and a small amount of orange, red, and purple fired mudbrick destruction debris (similar to the Phase 9 destruction debris) in the NE corner of the locus. Differs from brown mudbrick of L9968 and grey fill of L9954.

Relations: L9969 is covered by L9923. Since L9923 is the upper continuation of the leveling fill of L9954, L9923 is layed on the material of L9969. L9969 is therefore reached by the leveling fill of L9954. L9969 appears to reach the fallen mudbrick material of L9968 to the South, which is of a different matrix than L9969. L9969 reaches W9940, W9211, and the unexcavated material below W9914, which at the level of L9969 is the continuation of L9969.

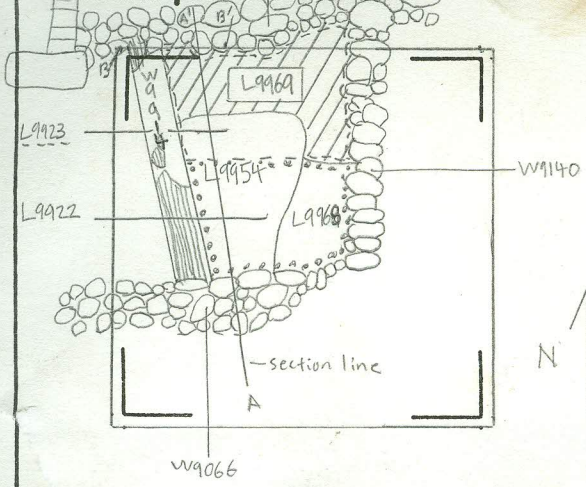
In the area of W9211, just E of its "corner" with W9914, W9211 floats an mudbrick material which is probably a continuation of L9969. This "gap" may be a doorway in an early phase of W9211.

IS 08: Collapsed burnt m.b. - phase 9 destr. debris.

Sketch plan

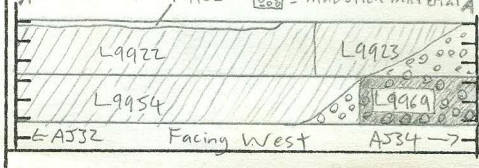
