Closed: Came down on floor F9971. End of season.

Matrix: Floor makeup of F9955 above was several layers of ash-white and yellow, approximately 1-2 cm thick. Matrix of F9971 is compact, dark brown midbrick debris with particles of light brown clay. There was a large quantity of rubble, from fist-sized to double hand-sized rocks. Came down

Relations: on clay floor similar to ^{basin} W9928 to the N. and area of in situ dark brown and further midbricks. Also came down on stones, rising the the patch of clay floor

RELATIONS: W/F9955 covers and seals F9971.

To the N. F9971 reaches the S. face of W9961

To the S. F9971 reaches the lower socle (phase D) of W9262.

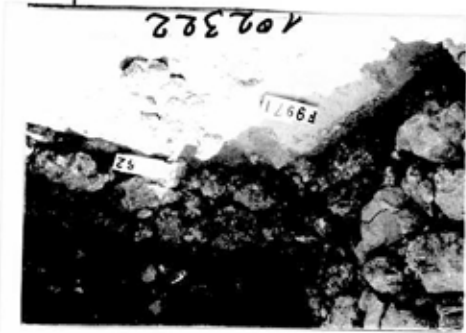
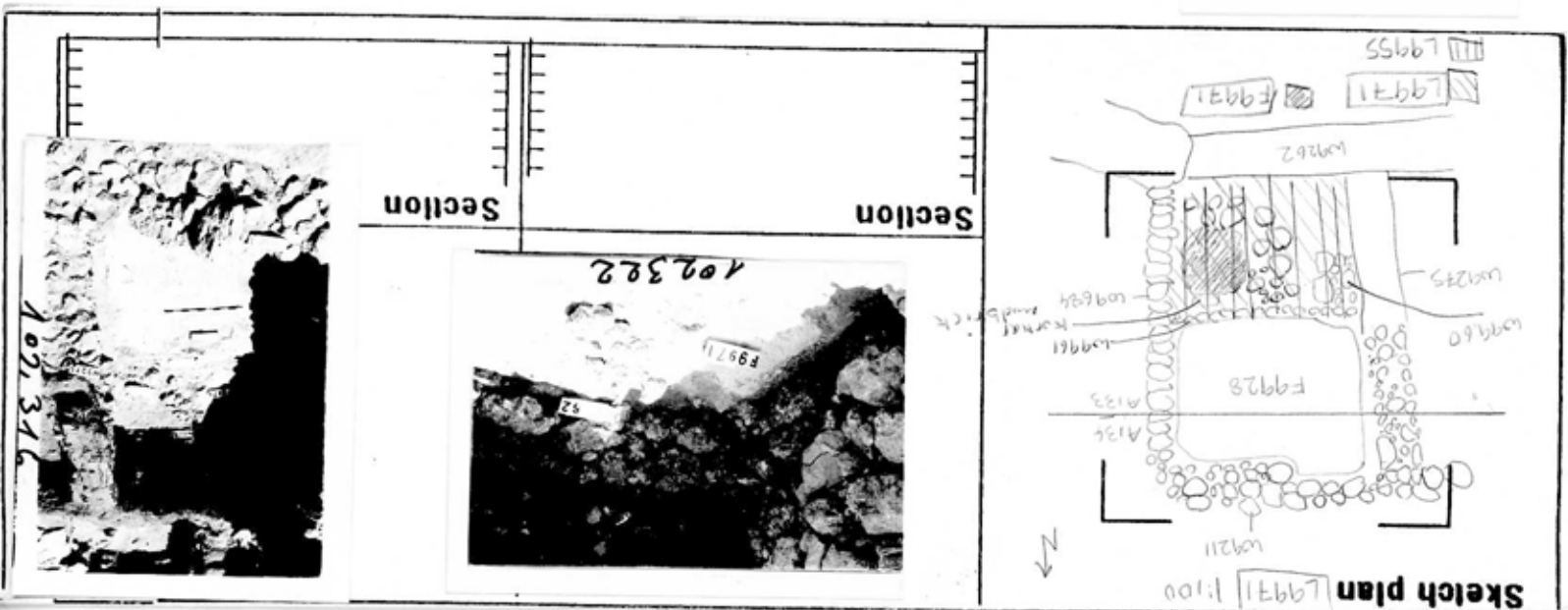
To the E. F9971 reaches the E. face of what is probably the third phase (from top) of W9684.

To the W. F9971 probably reaches (but may be cut by) the lowest edge of the single row of stones of W9960 and of the midbricks below the stones. F9971 continues to the E. into the fill below W9275

F9971 reaches the rubble surrounding it. This rubble is probably a semi-circular wall or feature associated with the floor. During excavation some of the rocks of the unnumbered feature were removed, including rocks abutting W9684.

F9971 is almost certainly a lower feature associated with F9928. High value; lower basin associated with F9928. See card 2
